1. Have you ever “conquered” or finished something significant? (Whether a personal or professional goal, an athletic or academic accomplishment, an addiction, a book, etc.)

SCRIPTURE STUDY: Romans 8:37-39 and Mark 6:45-52**REFLECTION QUESTIONS:**

1. Reflect on Sunday’s Scripture using the following questions:
What do you see?
What do you think it means for you?
What do you think God is saying to you about it?
What are you going to pray about it?
What are you going to do about it?
2. Look at verses Romans 8:38-39. What experience do you have with the things Paul lists as potential candidates for separating us from Christ’s love?
3. What does it mean to be “more than” a conqueror? It’s easy, perhaps, to understand what it means to be a conqueror, but why does Paul say, “more than”?
4. Name 2 things that are keeping you from God right now!
5. What area of your life do you feel “conquered” by and need to be encouraged in by the fact that you are “more than a conqueror” because of what Jesus has done on your behalf.
Share the areas you feel “conquered” in and then pray for each other’s conquerable areas.
